Jesus' baptism, by John the Baptizer, is described in the Gospels of Matthew, Mark and Luke. Our Episcopal sacramental view of Baptism stems in part from St. Paul's comments about baptism, in Acts 19:1–7. Indeed, Jesus' baptism was both the launch of his earthly work, and the basis for later understandings of Baptism as a sacrament, rather than the mere assertion of membership in one church community or another. Roman Catholics view the baptism of Jesus as a "Luminous Mystery", sometimes added to the Rosary. It is a Trinitarian feast in the Eastern Orthodox Churches.
