Consider

1. How to hold the center, when things fall apart;
2. How to hold a sincere conviction with “convicted civility”. What does that look like?
3. What are examples of authentic kindness?
4. Must we live in a world of total relativity or can we draw hard lines? How do we do that while embracing authentic humility and charity?
5. Is nationalism a form of idolatry?
6. Is our Christian view the sole gauge of “truth”?
7. Was Aristotle correct when he insisted that to be fully human was to function as a citizen, in the public square. What does that look today... In politics, in schools, in Church?
